

SFBB Performance Report - June 3 2025 - Jake Mulford

- Season recap
 - This past season we had 3 retirement home performances (The Templeton, Jordan Oakes, Stoneridge Gracious Retirement Living), the Dorcas benefit concert, and the Brass Band Festival (cancelled due to weather) for our performances outside of St Francis church services
 - The retirement home performance count was a little lower than the previous year due to lack of response from Windsor Point, Cambridge Village of Apex, and Searstone Retirement Community, and our shorter season (ending at the end of May instead of end of June)
 - We now worked out how to invoice for our performances at retirement homes
 - We need to include our W9 with the invoice
 - We need to make it very clear that we are a separate entity from the church
 - The Dorcas benefit concert was a huge success in my opinion, thank you John and Wendy for coordinating that
- Retirement homes
 - I'm going to prioritize scheduling at Windsor Point, Cambridge Village of Apex, and Searstone Retirement Community
 - I'm considering removing Jordan Oakes and Stoneridge Gracious Retirement Living from our list due to their performance area not being conducive for our band
- Next season performances
 - October 26th 2025: Retirement home performance (TBB has a concert this day as well, may move to either Oct 19th or the 25th)
 - November 16th 2025: Retirement home performance
 - December 14th 2025: Retirement home performance and/or Christmas concert
 - February 22nd 2026: Retirement home performance
 - March 29th 2026: Retirement home performance and/or Dorcas benefit concert
 - May 30th 2026: Carolina Brass Band Festival
- Christmas concert
 - I would like to do a collaborative Christmas concert with 1-2 other groups in the area (think like a small scale Carolina Brass Band Festival). This could be a Dorcas benefit concert, or just a fun performance. I'd like to see if St Francis could host us since outdoor concerts are not feasible in December
 - Ideally this would be more on the casual side, but that's not too expected for an indoor concert
